Rich blackberry colors and aromas of dried blueberries and allspice, this full bodied wine displays flavors of plum and black currant with supple tannins and spicy yet lingering finish.

Growing Notes:

Huston Vineyards Malbec, crafted from grapes grown in the Snake River Valley AVA of Southwest Idaho. The Malbec sites for this vintage hail from high elevation vineyards of between 2500 and 3000 ft. Our dry climate and long growing degree days make Malbec an excellent varietal for the Snake River Valley AVA.

2018 was a great growing season with bud break mid-April and a season in gradient temperature climbs providing exceptional ripening conditions. Most blocks were harvested the first two weeks of October. With high yields and exceptional quality 474 cases were made.
